A Message From Our Executive Director

As I reflect on 2022, my heart is full. With the help of our dedicated volunteers and donors, we were able to celebrate the lives of 1,306 homeless children. Our volunteers are indispensable to what we do. They wrap gifts, bake cakes, fill birthday party orders, create party games and party hats, serve on committees and the board, buy gifts, and deliver birthday parties.

But let's not forget our donors, who provide in-kind gifts and party supplies, as well as auction items. They also provide the funds we need to run the business and to buy gifts to fulfill specific requests when we don't have that cherished item on our shelves.

Why is all of this so important? Why do we care so much about giving homeless children the gift of a birthday party?

Because tens of thousands of people are homeless on any given night in Washington State, and thousands of those are children. When a child's world has been turned upside down due to homelessness, they often feel ashamed, lost, and alone, and as if the world has turned against them. Tragically, thousands of children are caught up in the homeless crisis on any given day, filling their lives with fear and uncertainty through no fault of their own.

Think about it. Homeless children have lost everything: their home, friends, possessions, safety, and security. Add the loss of a birthday celebration, and it only exacerbates the problem because these children may no longer feel relevant to the world around them. This often results in more shame, more anger, more hopelessness, and destructive behavior.

We know that recognizing a child's importance on their birthday has a positive impact. And Birthday Dreams does it day in and day out, by providing complete and custom-made birthdays tailored specifically for each individual child's interests and birthday wishes.

Birthday Dreams' mission is to bring hope, joy, and a sense of self-worth to a homeless child by providing the gift of a birthday party. Since our founding, Birthday Dreams has become a fixture in the non-profit community in the Puget Sound. We have provided over 12,500 birthdays to children-in-need. That's over 12,500 smiles, and over 12,500 moments of joy.

We couldn't do this without the dedication and compassion of our volunteers and supporters! Together, we bring light into the darkened lives of so many children, lifting them up and helping to give them hope for the future.

A Message From Our Development Director

What an amazing and record-setting year 2022 was for Birthday Dreams! I am so very proud of the work that our team did last year. Usually with the highs there come some lows – but last year Birthday Dreams really did have a whole lot of high points. One word really sums up what 2022 meant to me, momentum.

In the Spring, we organized our 2nd annual Miles for Smiles 5K virtual fundraising event. Over 125 supporters participated in this fun, activity-centered event. We hit our fundraising goal for this event and are now gaining momentum to make the Miles for Smiles 5K an annual event that gets our supporters excited and active each and every year!

Another crucial aspect of the year was raising awareness about Birthday Dreams in the community. What we do for the homeless youth in the Puget Sound region is amazing, but there are still so many people who are unaware of Birthday Dreams and what we do. To address this, we partnered with The Bull 98.9 FM and other local media outlets to spread the word about our work. Daily radio ads, weekly spotlight segments, and print ads and articles in local magazines all helped to increase awareness about the organization's work. Additionally, two TV segments featuring Birthday Dreams on KING 5 were a tremendous success. While there is still work to be done, these efforts helped the organization to become better known in the community.

A HUGE success last year was our signature fundraising event, The Gala of Dreams. On Saturday, October 8th we held our big event with well over 300 in-person and virtual guests in attendance. The Gala featured incredibly strong and enthusiastic client speakers, Melody Callier and her son, Jace, who shared their touching story about just how important Birthday Dreams was for them in a time of need.

Seeing the 300+ people in the Hyatt Regency ballroom that evening was amazing and there was certainly some magic in the air that autumn night. As the Gala came to a close, we witnessed some incredible Live Auction bidding battles and when the event concluded we tallied a record-breaking total of \$239,000! The success of the Gala of Dreams can be attributed to the hard work of the Gala Steering Committee, who did a wonderful job of putting all the pieces together to make it happen.

Looking ahead to 2023, we are energized by the successes of the prior year. With a strong Board of Directors and the continued support of donors and volunteers, the organization is well-positioned to build on the momentum of 2022. Still, the singular goal remains to provide hope, joy, and a sense of self-worth to homeless children through the gift of a birthday party.

Thank you to everyone who has been a part of a truly record-setting year! From our staff, Board, volunteers, and the thousands of financial supporters – you all make Birthday Dreams a shining light of compassion and joy in our community. I would also like to express my thanks and appreciation to the M.J. Murdock Charitable Trust for its generous financial support of my position here at Birthday Dreams.






Group Birthdays

Our Shelter Parners


The primary way in which parents learn about our services is through our partnerships with local shelters and non-profits that assist with housing. We have active agreements with 73 shelters.

A Message From Our 2022 Board of Directors Chair

My favorite quote is by the poet Rumi: "Be a lamp, or a lifeboat, or a ladder. Help someone's soul heal. Walk out of your house like a shepherd."

It is so wonderful to serve on the board of an organization that believes in the power of shared humanity, compassion, and caring for the most vulnerable in our community - homeless children.

From my own experience, I know that what you choose to do today can help positively shape a child's life. When a child feels celebrated, they feel loved and seen. They feel like they belong and matter. That is what Birthday Dreams does – every day!

In 2022 we were able to celebrate over 1,306 homeless children on their birthdays and surpassed our 12,000th overall birthday celebration in September!

From a financial perspective, Birthday Dreams had a stellar year. Some of the successes we had last year illustrate just how much momentum we are building.

- Foundation grant revenue this past year reached a record level, of \$175,000!
- Donations from individuals totaled nearly \$80,000.
- Our In-Kind donations were nearly 35% above what we did the prior year and the highest amount we've ever received in a one-year period.
- We also hit a record in corporate contributions, with a total of over \$20,000 in 2022.
- The Gala of Dreams was a huge success. On October 8th, we filled the Hyatt ballroom with 300 guests and raised over \$230,000!

And I would be remiss if I did not pause to thank our real change makers and heroes.

- Our incredible volunteers, whose resilience and willingness to serve truly made a difference. In 2022, hundreds of volunteers donated over 6,000 hours of their time helping to make birthday dreams come true!
- Our thoughtful staff and Board of Directors. Last year we welcomed two new
 Board members, Janet Barker and Amy Hartman who contributed greatly to our
 Gala effort. And just this past February we welcomed two new Board members,
 Kristi Auld and Becki Culbert. We are fortunate to have them on the team as well!

We thank you all for your unwavering passion, support and care in these times of need

I am so grateful to have had the honor and privilege to serve as the Board chair for the past two years, and I couldn't be more pleased to pass the baton to Janet Barker. Janet, thank you for saying yes and leaning in!

With our amazing Board leading the way, I have never been more certain that Birthday Dreams will continue its amazing positive trajectory in the years ahead!

Community Events

- **Decorate/Fill Goody Bags:** We provide the bags, ribbons, and candy. Volunteers decorate the bags with stickers or markers and fill them with candy and fun small toys that they purchased.
- Make Pin the Candle on the Cupcake game: Birthday Dreams supplies the paper with the cupcake and candles. Volunteers cut them out and decorate them using markers and stickers.
- **Create Party Games:** Come up with fun games that kids can play at a party. Volunteers put together kits with instructions that can be included in birthday boxes.
- **Decorate Party Hats:** What's a party without party hats? Due to the cost and lack of availability of party hats, we decided to create our own. Volunteers cut out and decorate the party hats for the kids to enjoy at their birthday.

1,487 volunteers participated in 76 community events, many of these were remote. Our top supporters were Microsoft, CarMax, and various school groups.
